

Instructions for Use


LALIZAS Hand-Held Flare ASTROS, SOLAS/MED/USCG, Red 74788

Emergency signal for position marking during rescue operations in day & night. SOLAS requires six pieces to be fitted in ships lifeboats and liferafts. May be carried on vessel's bridge.




USE ONLY WHEN AIRCRAFT OR VESSEL IS SIGHTED

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1

Hold the hand-held flare from the plastic handle. Unscrew the red cap.



Step 2

Pull the red plastic cylinder that appears downwards to ignite the hand-held flare.



Step 3

WARNING: When pulling the plastic red cylinder, the top of the hand-held flare must be pointed downwind and away from your body and face.

Don't fire the article if you can not control the absence of people within the safe firing distance and/or hazard zone.

WARNINGS

KEEP YOUR BACK AGAINST THE WIND - HOLD THE SIGNAL AWAY FROM YOUR BODY WHEN LIGHTS OR/AND BURNS.

To prevent hazards or injury use only is accordance with instructions and observe all warnings. May cause burns or injury if used improperly.

- · For outdoor distress signalling use only
- · Produces hot flame
- · Do not point at people or property
- · Do not use if damaged or dented
- Do not dismantle

- Keep away from source of heat

- Minimum Safety distance: 1 m
